①Sasaki Sake Brewery [Sake tasting and experience of decoration].

This is only one sake brewery existing in down town KYOTO. "Koto" meaning ancient capital and "Jurakudai" named after the gorgeous castle built by Toyotomi hideyoshi are very popular sake. After tour, we can taste sake, decorate a cap bottle and buy delicious sake!

②Nishijin Textile Center [Exhibition and experience of handweaving]

The museum introduces Kyoto's renowned traditional handicraft of Nishijin textile and displays historical materials. In the handweaving experience, you can weave a centerpiece mat (approx. 20cm x 30cm in size) to take home as a souvenir. *If you are interested in the experience, see Note③.



③ Kyoto walking [Historic tour]

We are visiting "Seiemi Shrine" enshrining Abe no Seimei, the ancient aristocrat with a charismatic spiritual power, and the sites of "Jurakudai" built by Toyotomi Hideyoshi and "Heiankyo". Enjoy exploring the town with a thousand years of history.

●In order to prevent the spread of the corona virus, participation is not allowed for anyone who is unwell or who has a high fever. ●Guidance and explanations will be offered in English and Japanese only. ●It is possible that photographs or images in which you or other participants appear may be used in media channels, for advertising by the regional taxation bureau, or on social media used by other participants.

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◆People who have consumed natto on the day cannot participate as natto bacteria can affect the sake brewing process. ◆No-one under the age of 20 can participate in the sake tasting experience. ◆Driving after sake tasting is forbidden.

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•You are responsible for paying the 2,000 yen fee for the handweaving experience (40 minutes is required). If you try the experience, enter "Handweaving" into remarks on the application site.
